





His literary work departs from that of the *Presencistas*, displaying a marked affinity for the styles and themes of the nineteenth-century Romantic poets.



Bell adds that he was "that rare thing in Portuguese literature, a poet who thinks" (p. 328). Born in Ponta Delgada in the Azores, he studied law at Coimbra from 1858 to 1864. He soon became a socialist, and after working in Paris and traveling in the United States, played an active part in the socialist movement in Lisbon. With the publication of such works as *Odas modernas*, 1865, *Primaveras românticas*, 1875 and *Sonetos*, 1881, he became one of the leading Portuguese poets of the nineteenth century. He retired to Villa do Conde in 1882, but never found peace of mind: nine years later he shot himself in a public square of Ponta Delgada.



Sixty four items acquired by Whitesell during his ten-years as rare book curator are described in detail, including seller's names, dates of acquisition, and funding sources. We have been told that due to rising paper costs, the printer delivered only 310 copies, not the promised 500.

FIRST and ONLY EDITION. This excellent work provides accounts of the ways in which the AAS has acquired important books, manuscripts, pamphlets, graphic art, and other materials over the years. The publication supplements the fall exhibition at the Grolier Club to celebrate the American Antiquarian Society's bicentennial year, 2012. *In Pursuit of a Vision* does not attempt to represent the breadth and depth of the collection, which would be far too vast for a single exhibition, but rather showcases those generous librarians, book dealers, members, and philanthropic collectors who have helped to transform Isaiah Thomas's conception into a national treasure. This highly illustrated

catalogue also features the individual stories that have come with some of their gifts, lending a certain richness to the exhibition. In addition, the AAS has published eighteen essays alongside these stories on topics ranging from the Society's collection development to bibliographic initiatives and collection stewardship. The American Antiquarian Society was founded in 1812 by the printer and Revolutionary War patriot Isaiah Thomas in Worchester, Massachusetts. The core of the collection is born out of Thomas's personal library, and has since grown to become one of the most comprehensive collections of books, newspapers, broadsides, and other materials of early America. The American Antiquarian Society was honored with the 2013 National Humanities Medal and remains one of the nation's foremost independent institutions for the study of American history.

FIRST and ONLY EDITION. Interesting exhibition catalogue. An introduction by Richard Zenith (pp. 11-26) is followed by a section titled "estudos" (pp. 29-84) with essays by Eduardo Lourenço, Arnaldo Saraiva, Ana Rita Palmeirim, Claudia J. Fischer, Nuno Júdice, and Fernando Cabral Martins. There are sections on "A arte de *Orpheu*" (pp. 87-108), dealing mainly with Santa-Rita Pintor and Amadeo de Souza-Cardoso, and including an essay by Ruy Coelho; as well as "*Orpheu*" visto pelos caminhantes" (pp. 111-32), i.e. António Ferro, Fernando Pessoa, José de Almada Negreiros, Alfredo Guisado, Luís de Montalvor, Raul Leal, Armando Côrtes-Rodrigues, and Stuart Carvalhais; and a "Cronologia" (pp. 135-57). The catalogue occupies pp. 161-242, including a "Bibliografia essencial à preparação do catálogo" on the final two pages of the section. This is followed by a "Bibliografia passiva" (pp. 243-67), and the indexes (pp. 269-83).
